Urban Non-Point Source & Storm Water (UNPS & SW) Construction Grant:

- Project must improve stormwater quality from existing development
- State reimbursement rate for engineering and construction costs is 50% up to a maximum state share of \$150,000
- State reimbursement rate for property acquisition costs is 50% up to a maximum state share of \$50,000



UNPS & SW Construction Grant:

- Competitive state-wide grants are awarded by DNR
- Grant applications are due to DNR by April 15, 2008
- DNR scores grant applications by September, 2008
- DNR grant funds are available by January 1, 2009



UNPS & SW Construction Grant:

- City can submit more than one grant application
- Use grant funds for wet detention pond, street sweeper, etc.
- Engineering and land acquisition costs are reimbursable if expenses are incurred before January 1, 2009
- Construction costs are not reimbursable if expenses are incurred before January 1, 2009. May be able to request early start date.

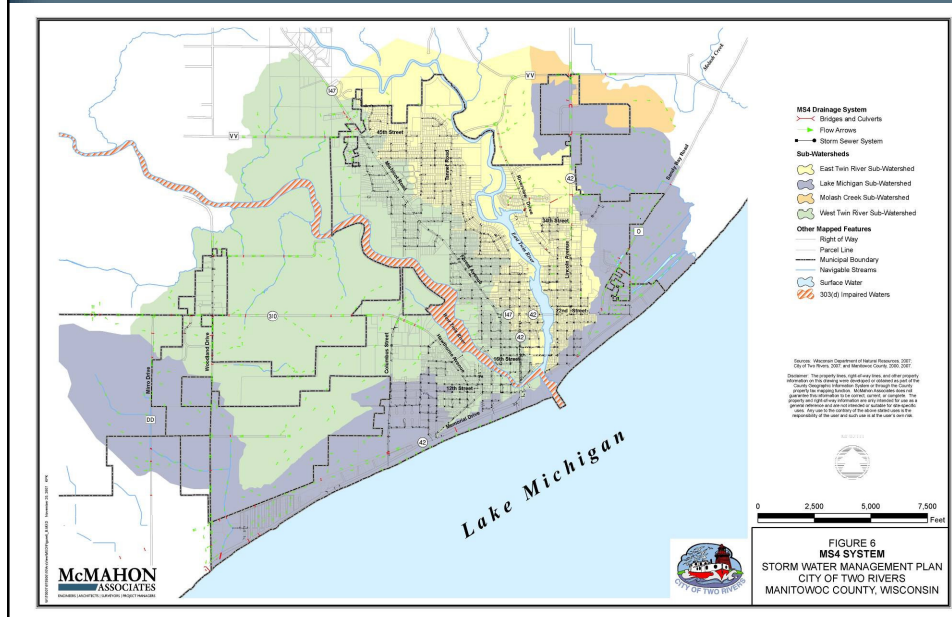


Competitive Elements of Grant:

- Permits are required if BMP is within a stream or wetland
- BMP must be cost-effective
- Evidence of local support for BMP (budget & public)
- BMP reduces pollutant load to a 303(d) Impaired Waters
- BMP protects a public drinking water source
- Many other competitive components (ordinances, resource management plan, water quality recommendation, City of Racine, etc.)

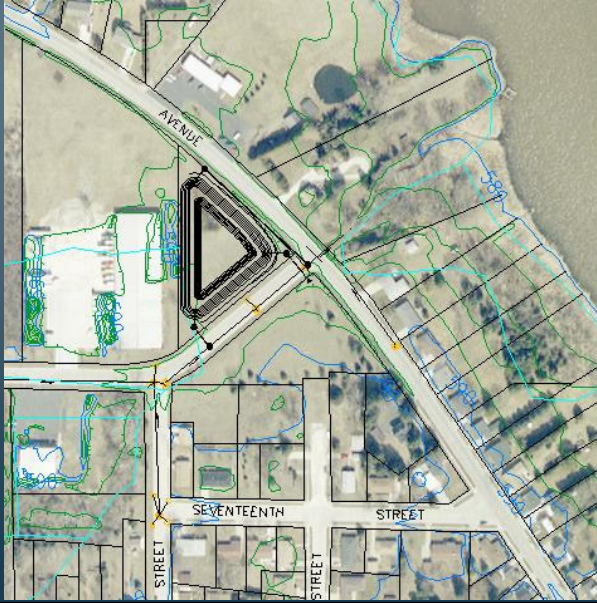

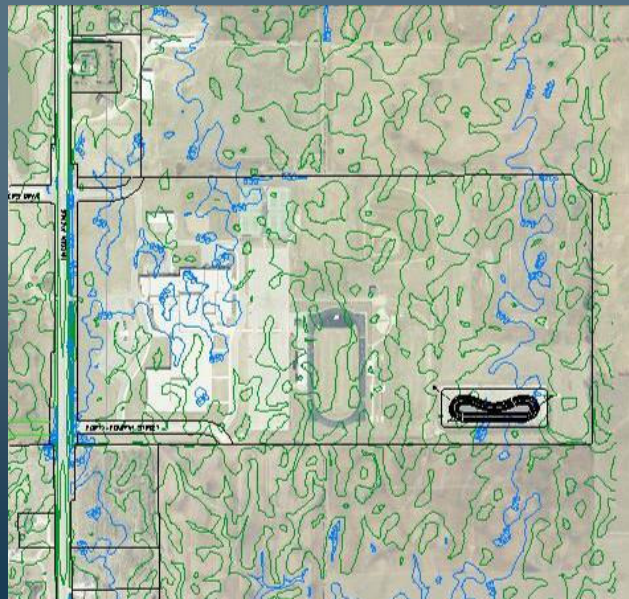

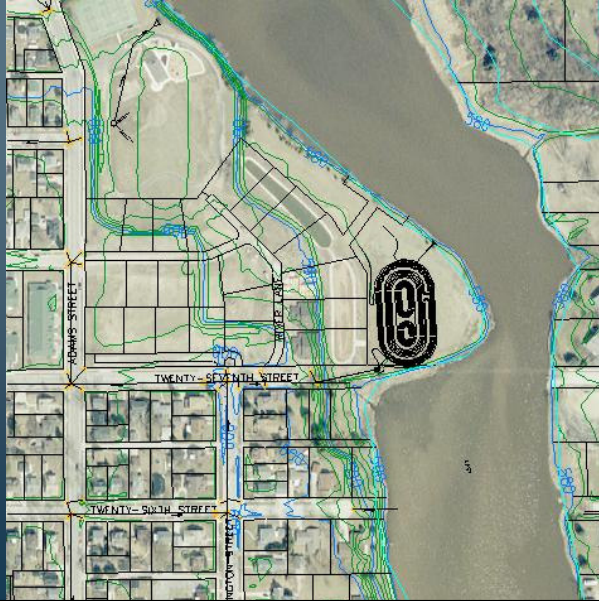
