

**STORM WATER TASK FORCE
THURSDAY, AUGUST 28, 2007
WOODLAND DUNES NATURE CENTER
MINUTES**

The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m.

OVERVIEW OF MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS OF ORDINANCES

Nick VandeHey of McMahon Associates reviewed three preliminary stormwater ordinances: illicit discharge, construction site erosion, and post construction management. Stormwater ordinances must be approved by the City Council by March 2008. He noted that the models of these ordinances were developed by the North East Wisconsin Stormwater Consortium, and the City of Two Rivers would need to address parts of the ordinances specific to our city. Mr. Pospeschil suggested that the illicit discharge ordinance address group carwash issues. The ordinances will be refined before presented for an ordinance review with the City Council.

It was noted that the task force should work to meet minimum mandated stormwater requirements at the minimum cost.

DISCUSS SCHEDULING OF FUTURE MEETINGS

The next meeting was scheduled for Tuesday, September 25, 2007, at Woodland Dunes Nature Center. The meeting will be an introduction to the development of a public education program. Tentatively, the Task Force will meet on October 9, 2007, to review the final draft of the ordinance before it is presented to the City Council. On October 17, 2007, Mr. VandeHey will present the Source Loading and Management Model (SLAMM) report to a joint meeting of the Task Force and the City Council. All three meetings will begin at 6:00 p.m.
